Main Street Gallery Call for artists & curators

Artists are invited to submit proposals for solo or group exhibitions of their work for the 2010-2011 Season (Sept. 2010 - Aug. 2011) of the Ketchikan Area Arts & Humanities Council's Main Street Gallery.

Curators are invited to submit proposals to curate a group exhibit based on unique themes or genres.

If you wish to be considered for an exhibit, please submit the following:

- **A cover letter** describing your proposed exhibit
- **A resume** or brief history of your experience and training, previous exhibits and current address and phone number (2 pages max.)
- **CD of Ten digital images**, labeled with the artist's name. Digital images should be JPEG or TIFF files, minimum resolution of 300 dpi and no larger than 670 x 1024 pixels total. Do not send original artwork or photos/prints of your work. It is imperative that you make every effort to provide images of the highest quality, showing a clear view of the work when projected. Images of work that exemplifies what will be shown in the proposed exhibit are more effective. (**Curators please note:** we realize that you may not have access to 10 images that illustrate your proposal. If this is the case, please contact us to make other arrangements.) Contact us with any questions regarding image format, or for information on digital image resources.
- **A numbered listing of images** on a separate sheet of paper, with the following information: artist's name, title of the work, medium, dimensions, and year completed.
- **A self-addressed, stamped envelope** with sufficient postage for the return of your CD, if you would like materials returned.

In evaluating proposals, the Gallery Review Panel will show preference for proposals by both emerging and established local artists, group displays by students or community artists, and curators who propose exhibits that engage and challenge artists and viewers. Preference will be given to artists who have not shown in the gallery in the past two years. Artists and curators are encouraged to give a public demonstration, lecture or slideshow at the Main Street Gallery while their exhibit is on display. Proposals are recommended by the Review Panel to the Gallery Committee and approved by the Board of Directors. The Gallery season is September through August, excluding December, February, and August. If you have a particular exhibit month in mind, please indicate this in your cover letter and the Gallery Committee will try to accommodate you. Exhibits open on the first Friday of each month and close on the last Friday of their month. Artists and curators selected to exhibit at the Main Street Gallery are required to be KAAHC members. **Please be aware that the gallery is a multi-use space and is used for various community gatherings-** your work may need to be moved to accommodate functions.

**All submissions must be received by
5:00pm, Friday, February 26th, 2010.
No late entries accepted. This is NOT a postmark deadline.**

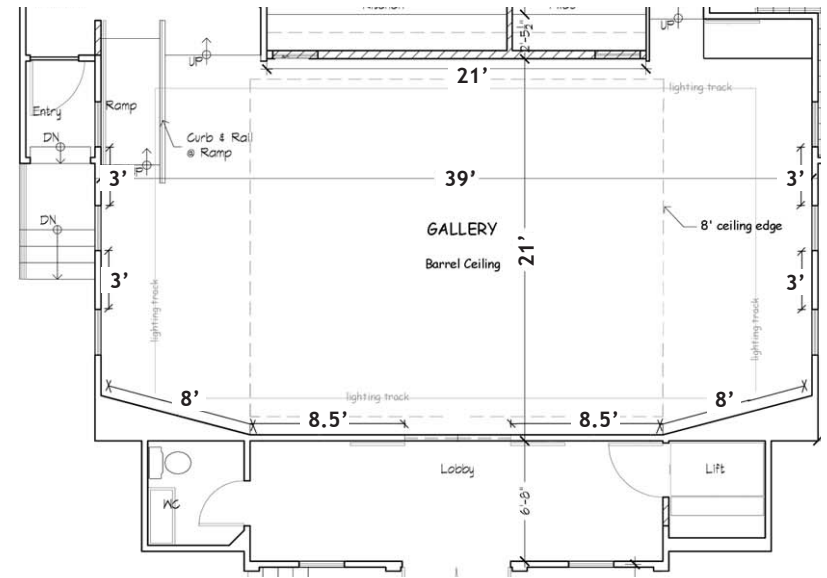
