BOOTH GUIDELINES

- **Last year's participants have until Friday, June 3, 2016 to reclaim their space or be on the waiting list to move.** Remaining spaces will be filled beginning June 6 from applications received on a first come-first served basis.
- You must apply for ELECTRICITY; it is first-come, first-served. There are very few electrical spaces in the parking garage (and is often problematic). No electricity is available in the city parking lot.
- An award will be given to the 'BLUEBERRIEST' BOOTH. A festive and well-designed display special makes the festival more fun and helps sell your items. The winner receives a FREE booth in 2016!
- Participants may not sell, transfer or switch booth spaces.
- Banners/posters are only allowed within your own booth space.
- Propane/Natural Gas usage *must* be inspected by the Fire Department. No generators/camp stoves allowed without written permission from the KAAHC.
- You must provide your own chairs, tables, booth, set-up/take-down crew, and extension cords (for booths who've applied for electricity).
- **Food booths must use a barrier on the ground, such as cardboard or tarps, and must provide large garbage containers/garbage bags. ALL food debris MUST be cleaned from the area!**
- No live animals as prizes or "give-aways".
- Applicants who cancel their application by July 15 will receive a full refund. No refunds after July 15, 2016.
- **We reserve the right to ask you to remove items from your display or shut down your booth if we deem items or attitude inappropriate for a family-friendly community arts festival.**
- **We also reserve the right to deny registration for future events.**

Guidelines for Artist Booths:

- Work must be original; works from kits or copies are inappropriate for the Artist Booths and will not be accepted.
- Work must display high-quality craftsmanship.
- **Use of the words "Blueberry Arts Festival, Ketchikan Alaska" is copyrighted by the KAAHC. Do not incorporate the phrase into your artwork.**

This is an opportunity to display your work for the entire month of August.
