

TRAVEL & MATERIALS GRANT APPLICATION

Open to everyone! Part of the mission of the Wearable Art Show is to provide a creative and supportive environment that nurtures artists' development. To further that mission, the following grants are available.

Materials/School grants

A limited number of supply grants (maximum of \$150 per accepted artist/class/group) are available to assist artists in obtaining supplies that will be used to create a wearable art piece for the show. We encourage classroom teachers and youth leaders to apply for assistance in covering youth group WAS projects.

Travel/shipping grants

A limited number of grants (maximum of \$150 per accepted artist) are available to assist wearable artists from other communities who would like to ship their entry to the Wearable Art Show, or would like to travel to Ketchikan to model their entry.

Eligibility:

Grants are based on merit as well as need. You must submit a complete grant application with all required attachments to be considered.

Grant Deadline:

5pm, Monday, December 4, 2017

Grant Notification:

Award recipients will be notified by December 12, 2017.
Grants are reimbursable—Keep your receipts!
