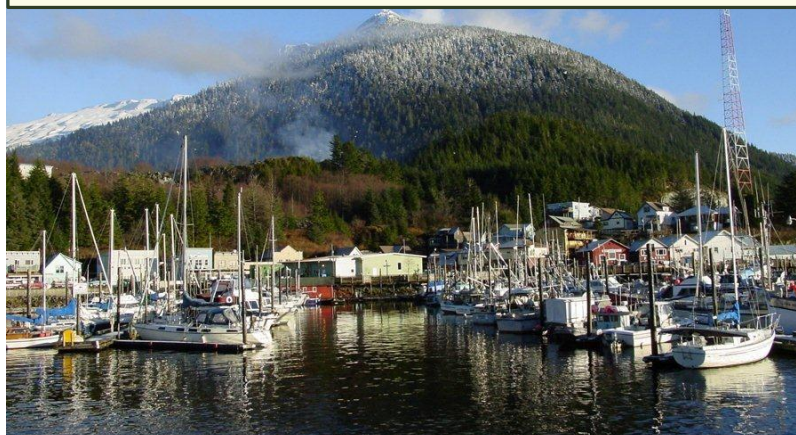

In this two-week summer intensive class, teachers learn to integrate a variety of art forms (visual, storytelling, drama, media, music, movement and traditional cultural arts) into their curriculum and instruction. Participants in this Institute will:

- Create and adapt art activities that engage all learners.
- Maximize student growth and performance through brain researched teaching strategies.
