Part of the mission of the Wearable Art Show is to provide a creative and supportive environment to nurture artists' development. To further that mission, the Ketchikan Area Arts and Humanities Council offers the following grants to artists.

MATERIALS GRANTS UP TO \$150

A limited number of supply grants (maximum of \$150 per accepted artist/class/group) are available to assist artists in obtaining supplies that will be used to create a wearable art piece for the show. We encourage classroom teachers and youth leaders to apply for assistance in covering youth group WAS projects.

TRAVEL/SHIPPING GRANTS UP TO \$150

A limited number of grants (maximum of \$150 per accepted artist) are available to assist wearable artists from other communities who would like to ship their entry to the Wearable Art Show, or would like to travel to Ketchikan to model their entry.

ELIGIBILITY:

Grants are based on merit as well as need. You must submit a complete grant application with all required attachments to be considered. Only one grant will be awarded per artist.

GRANT NOTIFICATION:

Award recipients will be notified by February 1st, 2021. Grants are reimbursable—Keep your receipts!

This is the Grant Application. You will need to submit a Wearable Artist Application by January 28th!
