Rules for the Handmade Human Powered Blueberry Boat Race:

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in the race, or to continue racing, is theirs alone. By participating in this event, each competitor releases the race organizers and officials from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law. Short version: This can be really dangerous, and all of us at the Ketchikan Area Arts and Humanities Council advise you not to do it. Really.

That said, the Handmade Human Powered Blueberry Boat Race promotes a fun, family-oriented event. Participants are required to act responsibly, show good sportsmanship, assist other participants if necessary, show respect for the water and boat/land owners along the raceway, and of course, have fun!

Captains are responsible for knowing the race rules and ensuring that their crew follows them for their own safety, the safety of other participants, and to ensure that we will be able to hold this event in the future.

Every team must have a vessel, without a motor, that has not been manufactured, but has been handmade by you. Or someone you know. No motors onboard, at all, even if they're not hooked up, disabled, etc. This includes motors and engines of any fuel type—that includes fossil fuel powered generators. **Human and wind power only for propulsion.**

Prize Categories are as follows:

- Fastest – Adult
- Fastest – Youth
- Most Creative
- Most Likely to Sink

The Rules!

BOATS:

1. All boats must be handmade.
2. Each participant **MUST** have a life jacket and [a whistle](#), and the vessel must have lines for docking and towing.



3. All boats must be solely human powered, self-propelled, but may use poles, oars, paddles, sails, etc. or any combination thereof.

4. Inner tubes or inflatable devices are not allowed, and any Styrofoam must be encased and secured so as to prevent abrasion/pollution.

5. No canoes, kayaks, boats, inner tubes, or surfboards will be allowed and decorating or covering one of these production flotation devices will be disqualified from the race.

6. All boats will be inspected prior to launching, and may be subject to modification at the discretion of Handmade Human Powered Blueberry Boat Race committee.

7. All boats and boat parts must be removed from the water following the race. There will be risk of penalties and fines for leaving your boat (and boat parts) in the water after the race.

8. The Handmade Human Powered Blueberry Boat Race Boss reserves the right to ban any boat from the race for any reason deemed necessary.

Participants:

1. All minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian or have present, written and notarized permission from parent or legal guardian. Youth ages 8 and under MUST be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian in their boat.

2. Each participant must have a Coast Guard approved life jacket that must be WORN at all times.

3. In case of emergency, crew members must be able to affect an immediate escape from the boat and must not be restricted in any way.

4. Crew members sabotaging any other contestant's boat will be disqualified.

5. Crew members must follow the instructions given by safety crews and Handmade Human Powered Blueberry Boat Race Boss and volunteers at all times, in or out of the water.

6. Crew members must not indulge in behavior likely to endanger themselves, other participants, and other boats.

7. The Handmade Human Powered Blueberry Boat Race Boss will withdraw from the race any crew member they deem unfit.

8. All local laws and ordinances regarding the use of alcohol must be obeyed by each crew member. Intoxication will result in disqualification.

9. The registered captain is responsible for ensuring ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS are followed.

In all matters related to The Handmade Human Powered Blueberry Boat Race, the Race Boss's decision is FINAL.
