MODEL EXPECTATIONS AGREEMENT

Please read the following rules and sign your initials in agreement next to each item.

These expectations are outlined in order to ensure that the Wearable Art Show runs as safely and smoothly as possible—and so you can perform your best! We all have to work together to make the show possible!

- _____ There will be two model workshops. January 17th and 24th, 2024 at the Plaza for anyone to use. However, if I have never modeled I must attend them!
- _____ I will participate in all four performances of the Wearable Art Show, Feb 1st, 2nd, with 2 shows on the 3rd!
- _____ I will arrive by 7pm for the evening shows and 1pm for the matinee show.
- _____ I will check in with the Stage Manager as I arrive for performances.
- _____ I will wear my backstage pass. I will not lose my pass. I need my pass to get backstage.
I love my pass. My pass loves me.
- _____ I will not go beyond the dressing room/ bathroom area in my Wearable Art piece. There will be a TV monitor provided backstage for me to watch the performance.
- _____ I will not wear my piece outside the dressing area, it is unprofessional and detracts from the actual performance. Until after the Grande Finale of each performance
- _____ If under 21, I will not enter the bar area without my parent/guardian.
- _____ I will have a BLAST wearing art work and performing for my friends and family!!!!!!!
- _____ I understand that the Arts and Humanities Council must always take into consideration the community's Health and Safety when putting on large events

BACKSTAGE

- _____ I will use my indoor voice backstage.
Yes, you've heard this many times before in Kindergarten, but... it must be said.
Backstage noise can be heard by the audience, and hinders backstage communication. Shhhhhhhh!
- _____ Respect the art, respect the artist. I will not touch or move the pieces of other artists/models, I understand many of the pieces are delicate, and I will not touch or move a piece of art unless it belongs to me or I have permission from the artist or model.
- _____ I WILL NOT USE A GLUE GUN BACKSTAGE. I PROMISE!!!!!!
We had one catch on fire. Seriously! Not only do you risk damaging other's property, blowing a breaker and possibly shutting down the sound or lights, you are putting everyone's safety at risk. Please just don't do it.
- _____ I WILL NOT CONSUME OR POSSESS ALCOHOL BACKSTAGE.
The Wearable Art Show is a mixed-age production, alcohol cannot be permitted backstage.
- _____ I will clean up after myself and remove all of my belongings after the final performance - even if I'm really tired. Please don't make a mess in the backstage area, including thrown detritus or spilled liquids - artwork may be ruined, and we are all responsible for cleaning the shared space. Do not leave ANYTHING behind Saturday night.
- _____ If I am behaving inappropriately and/or unsafely I understand I may be asked to leave.
